Managers' Report

1456 South White Oak Street has been given notice by the Lebanon County Planning Department to cease and desist their business and to remove business signs on the property.

ECS was contacted by letter from Township Office for proof of sign permit compliance. To date they have not responded. Supervisors will wait till next meeting in order to give ECS time to comply.

Lebanon County Commissioners have granted an increase (\$2850.00 to \$6991.00) to the Liquid Fuels Program.

Fire company tax reduction for volunteers as an incentive to inspire more individuals to volunteer for the various companies in South Annville. Supervisors will consider the development of such a program.

Banking/Financial Institution Rate Update resulting in the decision to stay with Fulton Bank. Invitations to bid on the Killinger Road Bridge repair will be sent out by Friday, June 16th.
