<u>Treasurers' Report-</u>Twp. Manger presented the financial reports for acceptance which included the following: Invoices paid and pending, Revenues received Treasury report fund totals /financial report. Motion to accept the Treasurer's Report was made by Supervisor Hoover; second by Supervisor Harrell. Motion passed 3-0.

<u>Citizens/Public Comments</u>- Resident Gordon Waldhousen expressed his concern about people driving thru excess water on Brandt Road at the bridge.

Engineers' Report- Mike Knouse of Rettew Engineering informed Supervisors that the lowest bid for widening Killinger Road from Hershey Project to Killinger Road Bridge was from JVI at a cost of \$112,910.00. He also informed Supervisors that Southgate a Landmark Development has a new representative, Patrick Dennis. In the ever on-going concerns with storm water in all areas of the Township, Mr. Knouse shared some costs associated with replacement and/or restoration or repair of the Brandt Road Culvert. Supervisors agreed to take the cost into consideration. The MS-4 Project covering 350 Linear Feet has all the Permits needed in place and if Supervisors authorize Rettew Engineering to Bid the Project for possible acceptance at the March Meeting.

Managers' Report- Township Manager, Donald Umberger informed Supervisors of the following: 1. Andrew Thompson of Garman Builders has requested an additional 36 EDU's for the McNaughton Project. 2. J7 Holdings, LLC of 417 Reigerts Lane has agreed to reimburse the Township for costs associated with the request to amend the Zoning Ordinance whether or not the Board actually amends the Zoning Ordinance. 3. The Township has received many compliments from residents about the great job that is being done in keeping the Township roads clear. 4. Communications with Annville-Cleona School District continues to allow for successfully working together.
