Managers' Report- Township Manager, Donald Umberger informed Supervisors of the following: 1. SA Township Solicitor, Josele Cleary will draft a Sidewalk Ordinance for possible adoption at next month's meeting. 2. Industrial Zone Ordinance is ready for adoption. 3. QWA has received an oral grant approval for hiring two interns. 4. Landmark requested a reduction of their LOC. 5. Off-Site Development Account CD Proposal. 6. Authorization was given to Umberger to speak with DEP about placing a hold on approval of Servant Oasis's Sewer Treatment Plan. 7. A meeting with FASP is scheduled for Friday, April 26th to discuss their 2018 Audit. 8. Annville Township Manager, Nick Yingst should have a draft of an Agreement between South Annville Township and Annville Township's Police Departments.
